RULES:

1. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern. The Senior doe and Junior doe shows are separately sanctioned.
2. The show is sanctioned by ADGA for the following breeds: Senior/Junior Does: LaMancha, AOP (Obs and Toggs), Alpine, Nubian, Sable, Saanen, Rec. Grade and Nigerian Dwarf
3. Show order for the Show will be: Ring 1 - LaMancha, AOP, Nubian, Saanen, Rec. Grade; Ring 2 - Alpine, Sable, Nigerian Dwarf. NOTE: LaManchas will show in both rings starting at 10:00 a.m.. Other breeds will start at 11 a.m. (or at the completion of the 2nd ring of LaManchas) with AOP in Ring 1 and Alpines in Ring 2. Breeds will show twice in the same ring with judges rotating between rings. Each breed will show only in one ring.
Junior does will show in the same order following the completion of the Senior Doe Show. Lunch break between Sr and Jr. doe shows.
4. ENTRY FEES will be \$4.00 per animal, per show and must be postmarked no later than September 6, 2011. A 10% discount will be given for more than 10 animals entered by same exhibitor family per show. All fees must accompany entries. Entries will not be counted until all fees are paid.
5. PEN FEES will be \$5.00 per pen (pen size approx. 8 X 8). This fee must accompany the entries. In state exhibitors are welcome to show out of trailers for this show but please plan to clean up any droppings or mess before you leave and please have your animals at ringside in a timely manner so we can keep the show moving along smoothly. Out of state exhibitors must be in place and checked in no later than 9 p.m. for Friday evening vet check.
6. Entries may be emailed or faxed but due date still applies and fees must be mailed by postmark date.
7. The original registration certificate is required for all animals 6 months and over. Stamped duplicates for animals under 6 months will be accepted. The date for computing age will be show date. The registration certificate or stamped duplicate must be presented to the show secretary at check-in. No copies of the certificate or unstamped application or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate. Reminder: stamped duplicates are only good for 30 days from date of stamp by ADGA.
8. No health papers are required for Wisconsin animals; however, any animal is subject to rejection for unhealthy conditions at the discretion of the show committee. Our policy on abscesses does not allow showing animals with an abscess balding or draining. All health papers and animals must be vet checked. All out of state animals must be accompanied by an interstate health certificate/certificate of veterinary inspection. Animals from MI must meet current tuberculosis requirements and have an entry permit. Please call (608) 224-4872 to verify health requirements and request a permit number. Scrapie herd identification must be presented at time of registration in order to show.
9. Animals may arrive any time after 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 23, 2011. Out of state animals must be in place and checked in by 9 pm on September 23 for a late evening vet check. All WI exhibitors must be CHECKED IN by 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 24, 2011. Animals must be out of the barns immediately after the show concludes unless prior arrangements have been made.

We will be ordering meals from Subway for the fall show. Cost will be \$5.28 for a 6" sub, chips and a cookie. Soda and water will be available for purchase at the show. Please fill out the following order form and include with your entries. We will be pre-ordering these for pickup just before lunch on the day of the show. Feel free to make additional copies.
